Thank you for your very generous gift to the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund. We very much appreciate your sharing in our mission to support the men and women of the Armed Forces and their families.

On June 13, 2012, the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund launched its newest effort: building centers to act as satellites of the existing National Intrepid Center of Excellence (NICoE), which our Fund opened in 2010 and which provides research, diagnosis and treatment for troops suffering from traumatic brain injury (TBI) and related afflictions. These NICoE Satellite Centers, located at several major military bases around the country, will extend the care currently provided at NICoE out to the home bases of many of the troops suffering the effects of TBI. Data from these centers will be transmitted back to NICoE and aid in its ongoing research program, helping to improve detection, diagnosis and treatment of TBI, PTS and related afflictions. The first three of these centers are now under construction.
